The Church, following the example of the people of Israel, since 1300 AD has had the practice of celebrating Jubilee Years usually every 25 years. These years are times of celebration of God's grace and mercy - times especially to receive forgiveness of sins and to offer forgiveness to others.

This upcoming year (2025) is a Jubilee Year, and there are special opportunities to receive extraordinary graces. As a means of receiving them, I'll be leading a pilgrimage to Italy next January and if you're able to make it happen, you'd be welcome to come along! The Jubilee sites will be focused around the Major Basilicas in the city of Rome.

Beyond those sites, however, we'll be visiting a number of places outside of Rome - places that are examples of God working in miraculous ways. Sometimes we lose site of how great God is, since we are surrounded by the ordinary. When we encounter the miraculous - when we see inexplicable acts of grace right in front of us - our faith can be strengthened, and we can become a source of strength to others.
